

Arrangements for Children

Applicable for non-Muslim separation

If you and your partner have children, the **Arrangements for Children** plan must be submitted with your separation application.

It is important to be as detailed as possible to avoid any misinterpretation.

The **Arrangements for Children** is an official template which contains 4 main items to be completed for each of your children:



Current arrangements

- Where they live, who with and who looks after them.
- The school that they are attending, or if they are working, their employer.
- Who is supporting them.
- Any current access arrangements.



Proposed arrangements post separation

- Where they will live, who with and who will look after them.
- The school they will attending, or if they are working, their employer.
- Who will be supporting them.



A list of any chronic illness or disabilities your children may have



If your children are under the care of any welfare officer

- Beginning date of care, expected length.
- Reasoning for circumstances.



The Arrangements for Children must be signed in front of the Commissioner of Oaths.

If you and your partner agree to the Arrangements for Children, you may both sign. If not, you must file separate Arrangements for Children and let the court decide.

Arrangements for Children

Applicable for non-Muslim separation

1. The present arrangements for the minor children of the family under 16 and those over 16 who are receiving instruction at an educational establishment or undergoing training for a trade, profession or vocation are as follows:

Official template wording

Child: Jessica Lum

- Jessica is living at number 12, Jalan Kumuning Palma 33/40f, Kota Kumuning, Selangor with her Grandmother Kok Siew Ee, who is the day to day caretaker.
- She attends St. Mary's school, at Persiaran Eria, Kota Kumuning, Selangor and is in Form 4.
- Kok Siew Ee, Jessica's grandmother, provides daily care for her.
- There are not any current access arrangements between her parents for Jessica.
- 2. The arrangements proposed for the children in the event of a decree being granted are as follows:

Official template wording

Child: Jessica Lum

- Jessica is to live with her father at 28C3, Block A The Coves, Jalan Bukit Rimau, Kota Kumuning, Selangor with her Father Lee Wei.
- She will continue to attend St. Mary's school, at Persiaran Eria, Kota Kumuning, Selangor..
- Lee Wei will become the primary caregiver and caretaker for Jessica.
- Access arrangements for Jessica are as follows:

All day Saturday will be spent with Jessica's Mother.
Chinese New Year Day 1-7 will be spent with Jessica's Mother.
2 weeks of each year, Jessica will go on holiday with her Mother.
Under mutual arrangement, the agreement can be shifted to other days or timings, as long as each party gives the other notice of no less than 2 weeks.

- 3. The said child is not suffering from any serious disability or chronic illness or from the effects of any serious illness.

- 4. The said child is not under the care or supervision of a welfare officer or officer appointed by a local authority or other person or organisation.
