

Single Affidavit

Applicable for non-Muslim separation

The **Single Affidavit** is submitted when you are filing for separation alone, or are responding to a separation filing from your partner.

Answer all questions in a very detailed, concise manner. Any item that is an untruth or cannot be understood will be rejected.

The **Single Affidavit** is an official template which contains the following information to be completed. It consists of 2 sets of questions:


Questions referring to your submitted Divorce Petition




Statements of acknowledgement



All forms of **Affidavit** must be signed in front of the Commissioner of Oaths.





Official template wording

Single Affidavit

Applicable for non-Muslim separation

- 1.1 am the petitioner in this case
- 2. The answers to Questions 1 to 8 above are true to the best of my knowledge, information and belief unless otherwise stated and where appropriate supported by documents exhibited herein.
- 3.I identify the signature appearing on the copy of acknowledgment of service now produced to me and marked 'A' as the signature of my husband [wife], the respondent in this case.
- 4. (Exhibit any other documents on which the petitioner wishes to rely.)
- 5.I ask the Court to grant a decree dissolving my marriage with [or a decree that I be judicially separated from] the respondent on the grounds stated in my petition [and to order the respondent to pay the costs of this suit or as the case may be].
