Answer all questions in a very detailed, concise manner. Any item that is an untruth or cannot be understood will be rejected.

The **Joint Affidavit** is an official template which contains the following information to be completed. It consists of 2 sets of questions:

- Questions referring to your submitted Divorce Petition
- Statements of acknowledgement



All forms of **Affidavit** must be signed in front of the Commissioner of Oaths.

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#### Questions referring to your submitted Divorce Petition

1. Have you read your petition dated .........

Official template wording

- Yes, I have read our Divorce Petition dated the ninth of January two thousand and twenty four.
- 2. Do you wish to alter or add to any statement in the petition? If so, state the alterations or additions.

  - No alterations are required.
- 3. Subject to these alterations and additions (if any), is everything stated in your petition true?
  Indicate which statements are true to your own knowledge and which to the best of your information and belief.
  - Official template wording
  - Yes, all content in the Divorce Petition is true.
- 4. State the date on which you both began to separate.

- My partner and I separated on the Twelfth of January two thousand and twenty three.
- 5. State briefly the reason or main reason for the separation

We both agree to separate so we can pursue our own lives separately.

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- 6. When and in what circumstances did you both come to the conclusion that the marriage was in fact at an end?

  - When we had a discussion about our future together.
  - This happened at our house at two thirty p.m on the twenty third of December, two thousand and twenty three.
- 7. State as far as you know the various addresses at which you and the respondent have respectively lived since the date given in the answer to Question 4, and the periods of residence at each address:
