

The **Cover Certificate for Personal Documents** is also known as the **Certificate Identifying Exhibits/ Documents**. It is an official template which contains the following information to be completed.

It is very straightforward form, allowing a commissioner of Oaths to verify that your submitted supporting documents are true.



There must be a Cover Certificate signed for each of the following groups of Supporting documents being submitted:

- Divorce Petition (regardless if Single or Joint)
- Arrangements for Children
- Affidavit supporting the above documents

E.g. If all 3 of the above documents have supporting documentation being submitted, 3 Cover Certificates are required.

If only 2 have supporting documents, then 2 Cover Certificates are required. It does not matter how many pieces of supporting documents are given, the Cover Certificate covers them all.



The Cover Certificate must be signed only by the Commissioner of Oaths.
