5. How is my contribution to the relationship viewed?
6. How will our family and children be split?

7. How much will the separation cost? And are there any other fees that need to be paid to you?

8. How should I communicate with you and send you my documentation?

9. Is there some form of child support I can claim later?

10. How does the court view the decision on custody?

11. What is the timeline to complete the separation process?

12. How are separation agreements enforced? What happens if my partners breaks it?

13. What documents do you need from me?

14. After this meeting, what do I do next?

15. What other options for separation do you have?

16. Can you also manage the process for property sale or transfer if needed?

17. I have a pre-nup agreement with my partner, is it valid?

18. Do I need to pay for my partner's legal fees?

19. Is there any government aid that can help me through this?

20. Based on my Questionnaire, do you think I need to go to court?

21. Can you help my partner and I draft a separation agreement that is fair for both of us?

22. What experience do you have in separation cases similar to mine?

23. What happens if my partner is hiding their assets?

24. If my partner is violent, what can I do?

25. How can I tell what my date of separation is?
